LIPIDS: from Membrane Dynamics to Signaling



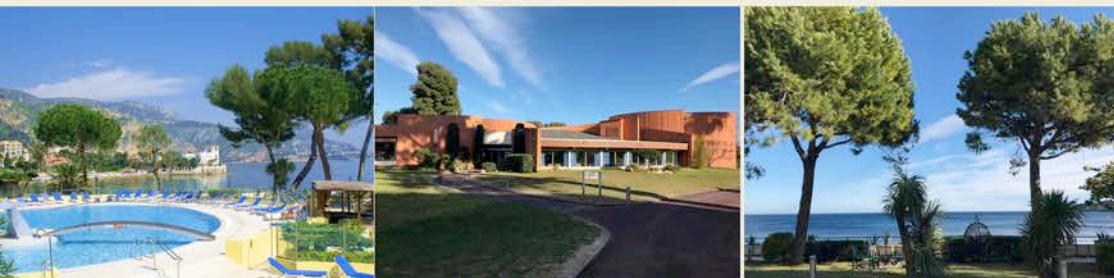
November 6-9, 2022, Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat, France
