CCI Campus in Strasbourg is connected to the Central TGV Station by the tramway public transportation system.

Tram A – 12 min ride from the central station to the conference venue. The same Tram A line connects the historical city center to the conference venue. Exit at the station Emile Mathis. The CCI is about 100 m walking back on the left side of the Avenue.

ACCOMODATIONS, HOTELS

We recommend that you stay in Strasbourg downtown as it is where you will have an easy access to the public transports, shops, restaurants and bars. Choosing an hotel close to a tram station will shorten the travel to the conference venue.

A limited number of rooms at the Ibis Styles Strasbourg Meinau Hotel next to the conference venue have been booked. Note that the hotel is close to a Tram A station and at a 5 min ride from Strasbourg historical center. **These rooms may be booked from the registration page, on a first come, first served basis.**

Poster presentation

Poster presentation will include a speed-talk oral presentation of 1 min max (mandatory if you want to participate to the poster award competition).

Posters should be mounted from November 3rd to 5th, on the designated boards and dismantled at the end of the conference.

The dimension of the boards is 120 cm high x 85 cm wide (47.2 x 33 inches). Adhesive tape and clamps for mounting the posters on the boards will be available at the poster area.

Nb: Landscape poster cannot be posted as there will not be room!

Oral Communication

Speakers are asked to bring their USB flash drive (preferred) or eventually their computer to the chairpersons at least 30 minutes prior to the session. The allocated time for all presentations is 12 min, plus a 3-minutes Q&A time.

CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE

A Certificate of Attendance will be provided to a participant for sessions that the participant has attended. A participant must attend an entire session to receive credit for that particular session. Late arrivals and early departures from a session will preclude a participant from receiving credit.
